#### Your role

Provide online teletherapy to clients who have been diagnosed with breast or ovarian cancer. Therapy is brief, often one to six sessions, for clients using Unite for HER's passport program.

This is a great opportunity for clinicians in private practice. We are looking for experienced clinicians (2 years or more post-licensure preferred) who have

- Experience working with people who have cancer or other medical issues.
- Experience in using mind-body approaches and trauma-informed care, such as mindfulness-based CBT, hypnotherapy, energy psychology, EMDR, and somatic therapy.

We are especially interested in bilingual (Spanish speaking) and BIPOC clinicians.
