Unite for HER may award up to three grants annually. The amount will be determined by the selection committee, and will not exceed \$1,000 per recipient. The actual number of grants given each year will be determined by fund availability. Only one gymnast per household may apply or be nominated. Submissions will be accepted and considered on a rolling basis throughout the year, and will only be awarded once per applicant/nominee. The application and all supporting materials must be included. Applicants/nominees will be contacted within three weeks of grant submission.

To qualify, applicants/nominees must:

This distinction will be awarded to a coach who loves to teach any child who wants to learn, regardless of their skill level. A coach who instills a sense of pride and accomplishment in the gymnast. A coach who motivates through positive and constructive correction, and doesn't ridicule or shame. A coach that lives to teach.

These are the leadership qualities John Pancott embodied during his career and that nominated coaches should exemplify as well. If you know a coach you feel should be considered, please read through the award criteria below for more details. We are humbled by the impact John Pancott had on the gymnastics community. Through this award, we hope to honor coaches who demonstrate these values and share his love of the sport.

Award Criteria

- Nominee must be a current USAG/JOGA/USAIGC Coach and employed by a gym attending the 2027 Pink Invitational.
- Nominator must be a current USAG/USAIGC/JOGA coach, gymnast, gym owner or Pro member. Only one nomination per nominee, please.
- If the nominator is a gymnast, a USAG/JOGA/USAIGC coach, gym owner or judge must also be included on the form as a witness.
- All submissions should be sent to pinkinvitational@uniteforher.org by **January 31, 2027**.
- An impartial selection committee will review all the nominations and select the 2027 recipient. The results will be announced at the **2027 Pink Invitational**.
